## Degree Promotions for Overseas Visitors

Send the application and thesis through the NGB at least 1 month before the promotion date to the ITF HQ.

Express your intention to grade in the IIC registration form

Pay the examiner grading fee (In cash) one hour prior to the grading.

Bring your ITF and NGB approval to grade letter signed by your NGB

Spectators are allowed during the degree promotion

## Travelling to the venue

By road – follow signs for Oxford from the North and East, or Abingdon from the South and West.

- Exit A34 at Didcot / Milton Interchange for A4130
- Leave sliproad and follow 3 signs toward Milton / Steventon
- Keep left on to A4130 and after 0.5 miles pass straight ahead at traffic lights
- After another 0.5 miles turn right (Ignore right turn into Featherbed Lane)
- After 100m turn left and then turn immediately right
- Follow the road for 200m and arrive at Hotel Milton Hill House

For Didcot Girls School

- Leave A34 slip road at Milton Interchange
- 0.2 mi Bear left onto A4130 towards Didcot
- 1.9 mi At roundabout, take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit on to B4493
- 0.3 mi At roundabout, take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto Foxhall Road
- 0.4 mi Turn right on to Manor Crescent
- 200m Turn right past the church into Didcot Girls School

From London Heathrow International Airport

Please contact UKTA if you are flying to London Heathrow and we will try to arrange transportation for you. Alternatively catch the Rail Link coach to Reading, and the train from Reading to Didcot Parkway.

## What to see in Oxford

Blenheim Palace - Visit the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill. A World Heritage site with over 300 years of History and home to the 12th Duke of Marlborough and his Family.



University of Oxford - The University of Oxford is a collegiate research university. There is evidence of teaching as early as 1096, making it the oldest university in the English-speaking World and the world's 2<sup>nd</sup> oldest university in continuous operation after the University of Bologna.



Oxford Botanical Garden - The Oxford Botanic Garden is the oldest in the UK and with nearly 6,000 different types of plant, the Garden is a year-round oasis of biodiversity, right in the heart of the city.

Bodleian Library - The Bodleian Libraries form the largest UK university library system, with more than 13 million printed items.

Ashmolean Museum - The Ashmolean is the University of Oxford's museum of art and archaeology, founded in 1683.

Radcliffe Camera - The Radcliffe Camera is a building of Oxford University, England, designed by James Gibbs in neo-classical style and built in 1737-49 to house the Radcliffe Science Library.

Wolvercote Cemetery - Burial place of J.R.R Tolkien (Author of Lord of the Rings) and Sir Roger Bannister (The first man to run a sub 4-minute mile).
